

# DISTRIBUTING FLYERS, ETC

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## **District flyers:**

Approved flyers that support an MISD organization (campus events, high school booster event, etc.) may be distributed to our students. We may also include that information on our campus newsletter and/or campus website.

## **Non-District flyers:**

Non district information or flyers must be approved by the Assistant Superintendent. An example of this would be a parent who wants to send home flyers about their business or a little league sports group. Once that information is approved, we will place the flyers in our kiosk at the front of the school for interested parents or students to take with them. We may place that information on our district/campus websites, if deemed appropriate. We will not distribute flyers to the children. This is an MISD policy. The only exception to this is Boy/Girl scouts, per our superintendent.

The campus will not make copies of flyers for students or interested parents. Business and organizations (district and nondistrict) must provide the copies.

## **Party invitations:**

We are not in the business of arranging play dates. However, appropriate, positive social interactions are good for your students. We do not hand out invitations as teachers because that looks like we are endorsing or promoting the activity. Teachers can help with this common parent concern/question by providing email addresses for all parents in the class, creating a spreadsheet, etc. Of course, you would need to have parent permission to share their information. A little work ahead of time on this (like at the start of the year) will save you many questions throughout the rest of the year.
